Article: What is CLIL? Five definitions of CLIL

By Phil Ball

1)Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL), in which pupils learn a subject through the medium of a foreign language.....

2)CLIL refers to situations where subjects, or parts of subjects, are taught through a foreign language with dual-focused aims, namely the learning of content, and the simultaneous learning of a foreign language".

3)It [CLIL] provides exposure to the language without requiring extra time in the curriculum".

4)"...an approach to bilingual education in which both curriculum content (such as science or geography) and English are taught together. It differs from simple English-medium education in that the learner is not necessarily expected to have the English proficiency required to cope with the subject before beginning study".

5)CLIL is about using languages to learn.....It is about installing a 'hunger to learn' in the student. It gives opportunity for him/her to think about and develop how s/he communicates in general, even in the first language".

Creating a portfolios encourages learners to take responsibility for their learning and encourages students to set realistic personal goals. Parents and peers can also be involved by including their responses to the portfolio. This is what should be in your portfolio for this course: Portfolios can be completely electronic or completely in hard copy form, or a combination of the two. Contents should be as follows: 1.Tabl of contents. 2.Short paragraph reviewing teaching experience and interests so far in your career.
